<p><u>Tie</u> is compulsory - obtained from school shop</p>	<p>Worn to cover top button of shirt and with eleven stripes showing. The tie must be visible if worn with a jumper</p>	<p>Too Short Wide knot No tie</p>
<p><u>School Shirt</u> White material Plain with collar No emblems Tailored blouse</p>	<p>Shirt or blouse to be tucked into students' trousers or skirt with all buttons fastened Tailored blouse to be worn just over top of skirt/trousers</p>	<p>Shirt not tucked in</p>
<p><u>School Trousers</u> Black tailored</p>	<p>Trousers must be worn on the waist. Trousers hem should not drag along the floor Trousers to be shoe length Belt to be sensible / discreet</p>	<p>Trousers should not be any of the following styles: Hipster cut Jeans Leggings Jeggings Tracksuit Bottoms Skinny / Drainpipe Baggy Flared Combat style displaying big pockets/ decorative zips Very tight or clinging material e.g. lycra</p>
<p><u>School Short</u> Optional (summer term only) Obtained from the school shop</p>	<p>School shop short only</p>	
<p><u>School Skirt</u> Compulsory – obtained from school shop Black with school emblem</p>	<p>School shop skirt only Worn at knee-length at all times</p>	<p>Skirt not to be rolled or shortened in any way Skirt should not be above the knee</p>

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<p><u>Socks</u> Must be matching pairs in plain black or grey to wear with trousers White socks to wear with skirts</p>	<p>Ankle socks</p>	<p>Other coloured socks Patterned socks Knee length socks</p>
<p><u>Tights</u> Must be plain black or skin tone</p>		<p>No patterned tights are to be worn No socks to be worn with tights</p>
<p><u>Shoes</u> Plain black leather upper or leather like shoe – robust, practical footwear For Health & Safety reasons, shoes should be such that the foot is fully enclosed</p>	<p>Shoes must be all black, including the sole Any logos must also be black Shoes must be leather or leather like in appearance</p>	<p>Trainers Sandals Boots High-heeled Platform sole Sling-back Ballet pumps Dolly shoes Canvas shoes Plimsolls (with or without laces) No logos or trim in a different colour Suede Canvas</p>
<p><u>Jewellery</u> Watch only</p>		<p>Earrings Piercings Plastic inserts Retainers Wristbands Non-school badges Necklaces Bracelets (wrist or ankle) Rings</p>

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<u>Hair</u> Natural hair colours in appearance	Clean and tidy Minimum of grade 2 cut Braided hair – bands must be same colour as hair	Mixed colours Extreme hairstyles including grade 1 or 0 cut Tramlines/shaving/patterns Mohican Extensions
<u>Coats</u> Coats should offer protection from the weather	To and from school Breaktime Lunchtime	Indoors Hooded tops In place of school blazer
<u>Hats/Scarves/Gloves</u> As appropriate in extreme weather	To and from school Breaktime Lunchtime	Inside
