**RE: 10SBL Thorpe Park Visit – Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2019**

I am writing to offer a tutor group fun day out at Thorpe Park on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2019. As the end of our first year together as a tutor group approaches, I am proud to say I've been really impressed with how the students have grown and developed through the year.

The cost of the trip will be **£30.00**, which includes transportation, entrance to the theme park and day trip insurance. If students wish to pre-book lunch in the pizza/pasta buffet restaurant, this can possibly be arranged at an additional cost of **£10.99** per student. Please indicate on the reply slip below if you would like me to do this.

We will be departing school by minibus on the morning of 14<sup>th</sup> July and return at approximately 8:00pm the same day. Students will be allowed to go around the park and on the rides during the day in groups of 4 or more and will be given contact details for a member of staff in case of emergency. Please indicate on the reply slip below that you are happy for them to use the rides independently. Some rides are age restricted and Thorpe Park staff will not allow students aged under 18 to ride unaccompanied. If a particular group of students wishes to go on one of those rides, I will try and arrange to meet them during the day but I cannot guarantee this.

I hope and believe that our students will represent myself and the school well and behave in a safe and appropriate manner during the day. Should I receive reports that this is not the case, I will expect the student(s) to remain with me for the rest of the day. I hope as many of the tutor group as possible will be able to participate as this will be a great team building day out.

If your child has a medical condition/disability please ensure that your child is not travelling on this school visit against doctor's advice. May I also take this opportunity to remind you that it is the parents' responsibility to keep the school updated with contact details and medical information about your child.
