Dear Parent / Carer

I am delighted that so many of our year 7 students have signed up to our Me- Learning scheme and are excited about collecting their iPads on Wednesday 18th October. Whilst in school we do all we can to ensure and encourage the safe use of iPads. Our filters prevent students from visiting potentially dangerous sites whilst at school. Sites such as Facebook are not available to students at school.

At home, it is possible for youngsters to be tempted to visit sites that are inadvisable. We are therefore inviting you to an e-Safety evening on Wednesday 18th October at 5.00pm.

During the evening we will be dealing with e-Safety issues and also ensuring that you and your son/daughter can get the best out of the iPad. We will give tuition on the use of Firefly and AddS. At the end of the session we will be issuing the iPads for you to take away and familiarise yourself with before students bring them into school AFTER half term.

It is a condition of the Me-Learning scheme that families attend the training session at school before being issued with an iPad and I look forward to meeting you Wednesday 18th October at 5.00 pm in the school hall.

In the meantime there are some links at the foot of this letter that I would urge you to take a look at.

Please bring identification with you such as a utility bill, driving licence or passport for the iPad collection part of the evening.

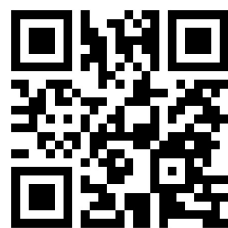
