Ref: International Day and Non-Uniform Day 2019

As part of The Arnewood School's status as a British Council International School, one day of the academic year is set aside as International Day. This year it will take place on Monday 1st July. The theme this year will be 'Great Figures Who Impact On Our Lives' with different learning areas looking at different figures.

The day will follow the standard five period day with the start and finish at the normal time. There will be a change to the lesson structure with students of all ages mixed together taking part in a range of different lessons and workshops. As a large number of the groups will be having a PE lesson on the astro turf, all students need to attend school on this day with their PE kit, including trainers.

As always, there will be an international charity element associated with International Day. This year the international charity will be The Butterfly Tree Trust. A charity that provides education and health facilities to children in Africa

In support of the charity, International Day will be a non-uniform day. Whilst this allows students to come to school out of uniform, clothing must be of a suitable nature to allow students to take part in the normal lessons that will run during the day. Non-uniform **does not** include jewellery, makeup, hair dye, open toed shoes or shorts. Students who choose to attend school out of uniform are required to make a payment of £2. All money will go toward the work of the charity. If students do not wish to pay the required £2 they are welcome to attend school on this day in normal school uniform.
