Re: RFU Rugby Ready Course

During the course of year 10, your son/daughter has opted to be involved in the Sports Leadership Programme run at Arnewood.

This programme looks to develop students' team work, communication and leadership skills as well as increasing their confidence levels when working with younger children. Throughout the year they learn how to communicate effectively when leading a session, how to organise and run events and how to be successful coach.

Your son/daughter has been selected to take part in the 'Rugby Ready' course run by the RFU, being held at Arnewood School on Monday 11th December 2017. The course duration is 3 hours from 1:00 until 4:00pm and will include both theory and practical elements. The Rugby Ready course is targeted at coaches and match officials and provides information on the importance of sufficient and appropriate preparation for training and playing while reducing the risk of serious injury. This will allow your son/daughter to further enhance their skills as a leader and to coach the basic skills of Rugby. The course usually costs £20 per person, but will be subsidised by the RFU, meaning the cost will be only £10 per person.

If you would like your son/daughter to take part in the course, please return the reply slip below to the finance office, no later than Friday 8th December 2017 with the £10 to cover the cost of the course. Please make cheques payable to The Arnewood School and write the student's name, tutor group and event on the reverse.
