Re: Uniform Rules

From time to time the governing body revisit school rules. At their meeting in March it was decided that there would be a change in school rules relating to jewellery.

From the summer term onwards, **students in all years may wear a single, small, plain gold or silver stud in their earlobes.** Clear or flesh toned, soft plastic retainers will also be permitted. No other piercings or style of earring will be allowed. To avoid injury during PE lessons, students must remove any earrings or retainers and be responsible for their safe-keeping.

I wish to stress that all other aspects of school rules remain the same including those concerning extreme haircuts and make-up.
