**Re: Splendid Productions - Orestia**

In section C of the written exam students are required to show an in-depth understanding of the practitioner Brecht; we have been extremely fortunate to work with Forest Arts to book **Splendid Productions** to perform their sell out production of **Orestia**. The company will then lead a 90 minute workshop on the performance and Brecht straight afterwards. Students will also be given an education pack that gives insightful detail to the staging decisions, characterisation and director’s intentions. I believe this will give students the best opportunity to gather a thorough understanding of Brecht and how his theories can be used in performance.

*Splendid Productions present an epic, murderous tale of family, history, vengeance and honour in a story nearly as old as theatre.*

*Condensing Aeschylus’s classic trilogy into an hour, Splendid’s regal cast of three retell the story of King Agamemnon, his queen Clytemnestra, and their children, Iphigenia, Electra and Orestes. A legendary family born to power, but destined to rip itself apart in a bloody cycle of tragedy.*

The production will be on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March, it will begin at 2:00pm, and students must be in A53 by 1:30pm at the latest to walk to **Forest Arts**. The performance will finish at 3:00pm and the workshop will finish at 5:30pm. Students will be dismissed from Forest Arts. The cost of the performance and workshop is £13.00, the cost of the performance alone is £8.00.
