Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 13 & 14 Examination Preparation

The commencement of A Level and BTEC examinations is a period of unavoidable disruption to Sixth Form students' normal timetable. However, please be aware that subject teachers will continue to be available at the usual lesson times throughout the examination period to support students in their preparation, and students will be expected to attend subject lessons until they have completed examinations in those subjects. Students with examinations scheduled in the afternoon are permitted to take home study in the morning of the examination, but would be expected to attend lessons at all other times. Students will still be expected to attend tutor times during the examination period.

If you are wondering how you can support your son/daughter through the exam period, my best advice is: that you ensure that they are revising effectively in a quiet area, that any part time work is kept to an absolute minimum, that their exam timetable is posted somewhere obvious and that they try to stick to normal routines of meal times/sleep etc. There is a PowerPoint presentation of specific revision tips for students in the Sixth Form student section on the 'public' domain area of the school website.

The A Level results will be available in school on **Thursday 15th August** from 9.00 – 11.00am. As per previous years, students A Level results will be emailed out at 07:30am to their **school email address**. This will allow students who have applied to University and need to access clearing, being able to do so promptly. I will be available on the results day to answer any of their questions.

Can I take this opportunity to thank you for working with and supporting the sixth form during their time here and wish your son/daughter the best of luck in the forthcoming summer exams.
