Re: Pantomime Visit – Jack and the Beanstalk, Thursday 7th December 2017

It has been a tradition of The Arnewood School to offer Year 7 students the opportunity to attend a local pantomime towards the end of the Autumn term, taking advantage of discounted school group rate tickets that are only available during the day. This is not a mandatory part of their curriculum and so there is no requirement for them to attend if you do not wish them to do so.

This year we plan to offer Year 7 a trip to the Pantomime in Bournemouth to see Jack and the Beanstalk, for which we have been able to obtain 100 tickets. In the event that more than 100 students apply to attend, places will be allocated on a random and equitable basis.

The trip will depart school on Thursday 7th December at 1pm and return at approximately 6pm. The cost of the trip is £16.00 and includes coach travel plus an ice-cream in the interval. Students should wear normal school uniform and bring a packed lunch for that day and make sure they have their equipment/books for lesson 1 to 4.

Cheques are to be made payable to The Arnewood School with the student's name, tutor group and event on the reverse. Please return the reply slip below together with the payment to the Finance Office by Friday 22nd September 2017.
