Re: Year 9 Osmington Bay Residential Trip

Following two very successful residential trips in Years 7&8, we are excited to offer another experience for students to build confidence, self-esteem, motivation and teamwork skills. This year we have chosen Osmington Bay, Weymouth.

Osmington Bay is run by the experienced adventure holiday company, PGL, who we were very impressed with when we went to Little Canada last year. This is one of their biggest centres with superb facilities, great watersports and a wide range of activities. Watersports take place on the nearby Isle of Portland, at the multi-million pound facility where the 2012 Olympic sailing events were held.

It is proposed that the residential trip will take place from **Friday 10th May 2019**, returning on the evening of **Sunday 12th May 2019**. The cost of the trip will be **£130.00**, which includes travel by coach, full board with chalet accommodation and use of the facilities at the Centre with qualified instructors.

If you would like your son/daughter to take part in the visit please complete the reply slip below and return it together with a **non-returnable deposit of £40.00** to the Finance office by **Friday 5th October 2018**. In the event that there is insufficient demand to run this trip, deposits will be refunded in full. Cheques to be made payable to The Arnewood School with the student's name, tutor group and event on the reverse.

Although you are welcome to pay the entire amount as one instalment, payable by Friday 12th October 2018, I am planning on spreading out the payment for this trip in instalments over the course of the year, my suggested payment terms are:-

- £40 deposit to be paid by Friday 5th October 2018
- £40 to be paid by Friday 2nd November 2018
- £50 to be paid by Friday 1st February 2019
