Each lesson is 1 hr 30 minutes and there is only one lesson for each subject per week. For Business Studies, Psychology and Law there are 2 classes, for example Business Studies 1 and 2. This will allow the group to be split in order to reduce the number of students in each class. All teaching groups will have no more than 12 students.

If you usually travel to sixth form via the school Laguna coach we are unfortunately unable to offer this service through this summer half term block.
