Re: Arrangements for the New Term September 2020

Can I take this opportunity to congratulate you on some of the excellent work you have produced both at home and during the past few weeks of face-to-face teaching and the supplementary live lessons. Teachers have regularly been in contact with me to say how impressed they are. I can now confirm students will start back on **Friday 4th September** and enrol at 1.00pm until 3.00pm meeting in the school hall. 
For those of you that took AS Level examinations, since writing to you earlier this month, the JCQ have changed the guidance on the time the examination results can be released. The new time for your A Level results to be **emailed to your school email address is 08.00am on Thursday 13th August**.
