## Re: The Mayflower Theatre – An Inspector Calls

There is an exciting opportunity for GCSE English Literature students to see a live performance of J.B Priestley's *An Inspector Calls* at the Mayflower Theatre in Southampton on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022.

Year 11 have read and studied *An Inspector Calls* in Year 10 but will need to revise this play for part of their end of Year 11 GCSE examination for English Literature. This is a closed book examination and students will need to know the plot, characters, themes and quotations really well. Therefore, this experience would be invaluable to their understanding and revision of a GCSE examination topic.

The Mayflower have reserved 50 student tickets for us. The cost of the visit is £27 per student.

The performance starts at 7.30pm. A coach has been booked to take us to Southampton from school and will need to leave at 6pm. The running of the performance is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes with no interval. Therefore, the performance should end around 9.30pm and I would hope that the coach would return to Arnewood by 10.30pm at the latest. Students will need to be collected from school by a parent/carer, as it will be late at night.
