Re: The Victoria and Albert Museum, London on Tuesday 27th June

The Arnewood Technology and Art departments would be delighted to offer your child a place on a trip to The Victoria and Albert Museum, London.

Students will get first-hand experience of artwork, artifacts, and fashion from a variety of eras. This will be documented in their GCSE sketchbooks in year 10 and will be used to inform and inspire their project work. Although not a necessary part of the course – it will enrich the experience at GCSE and give students valuable insight into how they may wish to pursue a creative career. There will also be opportunities to engage with a mini photographic workshop with the Head of Photography and attending A-level Photography students.

The visit has been booked for **Tuesday 27th June** and will cost **£22.00** (this includes the cost of the coach and parking in London). Places will be on a random and equitable basis if over subscribed.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch, and any additional drinks/snacks as we plan to leave Arnewood at **7.30am** and hope to return by approximately **6pm** depending on traffic. Students will not be allowed to eat on the coach but there will be opportunities to have a snack before we return. Students will be required to wear full school uniform on this trip.
